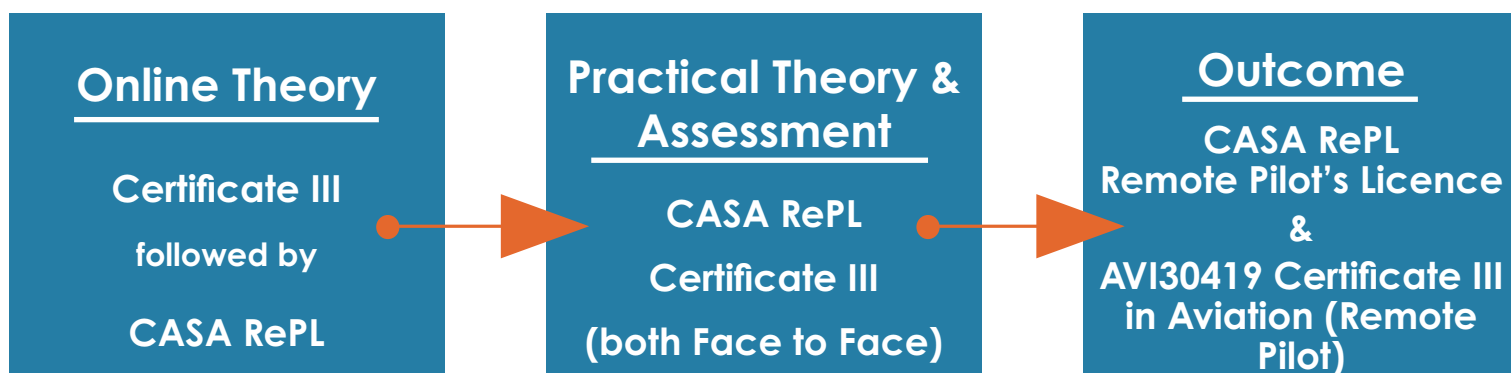

THE COURSE WILL SUIT YOU IF

You conduct or are planning to conduct drone related activities in your workplace and where a CASA RePL is a requirement or for risk mitigation purposes.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

This course has been modified to allow students to undertake all theory components of their course upfront. As soon as social distancing measures are lifted and all theory components are complete, you can work with Skills Generation Trainers to undertake your practical training and assessment.

This qualification would suit you if you are operating remotely piloted aircraft systems (RPAS) within visual line of sight (VLOS), below 400 feet above ground level (AGL), in day visual meteorological conditions (VMC), outside of controlled airspace, greater than 3 nautical miles from an aerodrome, outside of populous areas.

Remote pilot duties include applying technical and non-technical aviation skills and knowledge within RPAS operational environments.

This qualification forms some of the requirements for certification by the Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) as described in Civil Aviation Safety Regulation (CASR) Part 101 Division 101.F.3—Certification of UAV controllers.

As well as gaining your qualification upon successful completion of this course, you will also qualify for your CASA Remote Pilot's Licence.

There is a maximum 12 month enrolment for this course but it is anticipated that most students will complete sooner.

HOW CAN I DO THIS COURSE

This course has been designed specifically for those who already operate an RPAS but who do not hold a CASA RePL Licence. The practical assessments for both the Certificate III qualification and the CASA Licence can only be conducted if the student already has five hours of documented flying of their RPA.

Students will need to undertake online theory learning and assessment for both the CASA RePL and the gap training for the Certificate III. The practical assessments will be conducted face to face as negotiated with your trainer after completion of the theory components and verification of your documented five hours of flying.

ABOUT RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING (RPL)

If you are currently working or have worked in a relevant industry, you may be eligible for RPL. Give us a call and we can talk through your particular needs with you.

WHAT IS MY INVESTMENT?

This course currently attracts funding through the Queensland Government Certificate 3 Guarantee program if you meet certain eligibility criteria. Your out of pocket expense for the course is \$250.

NEED YOUR AROC?

The AROC (Aeronautical Radio Operator Certificate) theory is covered in this qualification. If you wish to sit the exam for your CASA AROC, there is an additional fee of \$300. CASA AROC assessment can be done at the same time as your RePL practicals.
